

Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act Board

Notice is hereby given of a public hearing of the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act Board, to be held December 12, 2024, beginning at 1:00 pm CDT, in the Hearing Room 1525, State Capitol, Lincoln NE. 68509. The hearing is to receive documentary evidence and testimony regarding a joint application submitted by the City of Omaha, Nebraska and Omaha Performing Arts for financial assistance under the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-3101 through 13-3110. The City of Omaha and Omaha Performing Arts (O-pa) are seeking financial assistance to aid in the promotion of arts and cultural events at O-pa's new Tenaska Center for Arts Engagement. The facility will be located east of the Holland Center at 12th Street between Dodge and Douglas and south of Steelhouse Omaha. Specifically, the funds will be used to promote O-pa's learning and engagement programs that will serve students, teachers, and the greater Omaha community.
